Tasting Notes	Ripe fruit aromas focused on dark berries such as huckleberries and blueberries are enveloped by a bouquet of cocoa powder and suede. The palate ex- hibits crème de Cassis along with hints of cardamom spice balancing a structure that is characterized by smooth and ripe tannins, products of a sophisticated oak regimen.			
Winemaking Notes	Kiara Bella opens up a gateway to a sun drenched oasis of rolling hills basking in summer heat. Boasting aromas of adventure and flavors of free time, this Paso Robles representation of French and Italian varietals layers juicy dark fruit over sunbaked rustic structure, gently dappled with spice from relaxing in oak barrels.
